PASTORAL LETTER

Sisters and Brothers.

Delighted to welcome All to the worship of the living God. May the Fount of every blessing tune our hearts to sing God's praise.

If I were to ask the men and women of the congregation "what is intimacy"? the answers would be distinctly

different. For the women, intimacy would have to do with holding hands, engaging in two hours conversation, having dinner together home or out. For the men, it would involve hugs and kisses. In other words, for women intimacy is relational but for men it is physical.

I want to side with the women on this issue to say that intimacy is about interacting and engaging such that women and men learn the ways, tendencies and habits of the heart of each other. In siding with the women what I am saying is this: intimacy is a **face to face** relationship rather than a **side by side** relationship.

Now, is it not the case, oftentimes, that men's relationship with God, the church, their wives and children are side by side, not face to face? At times, men will act out of duty or obligation but not out of an intention to know, to draw closer; provide but not engage; give but not talk; be present but keep far and reveal but nothing is known. Such was not the case with the biblical character, Enoch.

Genesis 5:24 indicates that while the other men lived, Enoch walked with God. The text does not explain what this description of Enoch's life means. Whatever "walk" means, we are told that it was done with God. We know, however, as the people called Methodists, that "walk" has to do with how we live our lives. Persons who are being prepared for full membership in the Methodist church are regarded as "walking for Confirmation". Walking with God means to be habitually cultivating a face to face relationship with God. In so doing, One experiences mespecific knowledge of God and has an open relationship with God; One converses with God about weaknesses, longings, depraved tastes, troubles, pains, joys, evil in the heart, temptations and angers.

On this men's day, I challenge as I invite the men to habitually cultivate a face to face relationship with God. When you do, you will discover that you know more about God than your jobs, tools and drinks; and more about your Bible than your vehicles. Men, we have responsibilities to undertake, examples to set, lives to mould, sacrifices to make, discipline to exercise and love to shower. The church and our families will be the better for face to face relationships and such will put us in good stead when we shall stand face to face before God.

I pray for All a week that is good, one in which we habitually cultivate face to face relationships with God, the church and family.
