Dear Father, help all our leaders - religious, political, business, and the head of families, to fully surrender their lives to Christ Jesus as Mary and Joseph did and experience the glory that they received because of their faith in you. Lord, in your mercy.....

We think, O Lord, of the Angels who proclaimed the birth of Jesus with a song of joy and who announced that peace comes to all with whom you are pleased.
